## HAZARDOUS HOUSEHOLD WASTE RECYCLING DEPOT

Here is the list of materials that will be recycled on that day:

<p><b>PAINTS</b></p> <p>Paints:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• sold by retail businesses (100 ml containers and larger)</li><li>• sold by wholesale businesses (170 L containers and larger intended for architectural use)</li><li>• primers and paints (latex, alkyd, enamel and other)</li><li>• metal or anti-rust:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• aluminium paint</li><li>• dyes</li><li>• varnishes</li></ul></li><li>• lacquers</li><li>• products or preparations for the treatment of wood (preservatives) or masonry (acrylic sealers for driveways)</li><li>• signalisation paints (those available in retail businesses)</li></ul> <p>Aerosol paints</p>	<p><b>ORGANIC HAZARDOUS HOUSEHOLD WASTE</b></p> <p>Acetone, adhesives, aerosols, solid fire starter, rubbing alcohol, starter fluid, glue, wax, antifreeze, caulking, dye, plastic cement, solid fuel, fondue fuel, lock de-icer, degreasing agents, oil stain remover, paint thinner, petroleum distillate, ink, epoxy, gasoline, ethylene glycol, roofing tar, motor grease, heating and lamp oil, lubricant, methanol, petroleum, polish, Polyfilla, leather, suede or vinyl protector, liquid resin, silicone sealant, wallpaper remover, shoe dye, turpentine, toluene</p> <p><b>INORGANIC HAZARDOUS HOUSEHOLD WASTE</b></p> <p>Acids, bases, oxidizing agents, batteries, pesticides and insecticides</p> <p>Fluorescent compact lightbulbs (CFL)</p>

**Each container must be intended for residential use only.**

**All products must be in their original container.**

**For safety reasons, do not mix products.**

During this collection, you may also take in your used oil, used filters and oil containers (**non commercial use only**). This service is also offered free of charge throughout the year by the municipality. Please call before dropping off your oil products.
